Revised supplementary provisional agenda

I. Introduction

1. The secretariat received a request from the Islamic Republic of Iran, on behalf of the Like-minded Developing Countries, in a communication dated 26 October 2017, to include an item on the provisional agenda for the twenty-third session of the Conference of the Parties (COP).
2. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the President of COP 22, this item is included on the supplementary provisional agenda below as item 5.

II. Supplementary provisional agenda

3. The supplementary provisional agenda for COP 23, proposed after consultation with the President of COP 22, is as follows:
 1. Opening of the session.
 2. Organizational matters:
 - (a) Election of the President of the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-third session;
 - (b) Adoption of the rules of procedure;
 - (c) Adoption of the agenda;
 - (d) Election of officers other than the President;
 - (e) Admission of organizations as observers;



- (f) Organization of work, including for the sessions of the subsidiary bodies;
 - (g) Dates and venues of future sessions;
 - (h) Adoption of the report on credentials.
3. Reports of the subsidiary bodies:
 - (a) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice;
 - (b) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation;
 - (c) Report of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement.
 4. Preparations for the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the first session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement.

III. Annotations to the supplementary provisional agenda

5. Accelerating the implementation of the pre-2020 commitments and actions and increasing the pre-2020 ambition in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 of decision 1/CP.19

4. *Background:* By way of a communication dated 26 October 2017, the Islamic Republic of Iran, on behalf of the Like-minded Developing Countries, requested the addition of this agenda item to the provisional agenda for COP 23.

5. In this request, the Islamic Republic of Iran stated that the purpose of this agenda item would be to:

- (a) Take stock of the collective progress made in implementing pre-2020 commitments and actions and increasing ambition, in particular on the provision of support;
- (b) Identify linkages and strengthen synergy with other agenda items and processes under the COP, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol and the subsidiary bodies related to pre-2020 implementation and ambition, including item 16 of the supplementary provisional agenda for COP 23, “Assessment of the technical examination processes on mitigation and adaptation”;
- (c) Discuss the report on the 2016 facilitative dialogue and related experience and lessons learned with a view to informing the consultations on the organization of the 2018 facilitative dialogue;

(d) Determine further concrete activities and technical work to be undertaken until 2020 to accelerate pre-2020 implementation and increase pre-2020 ambition.

6. *Action:* The COP will be invited to consider this matter and to take any action it deems appropriate.
