I. Introduction



 - 4. *Background*: SBI 46 considered the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2018–2019 and recommended that the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its twenty-third session approve a core programme budget of EUR 56,889,092 for the biennium 2018–2019. As requested at SBI 46, the secretariat prepared a revised work programme² with budget allocations based on documents FCCC/SBI/2017/4/Add.1 and FCCC/SBI/2017/INF.8 and the inputs received from and views expressed by Parties, for consideration at SBI 47.³
