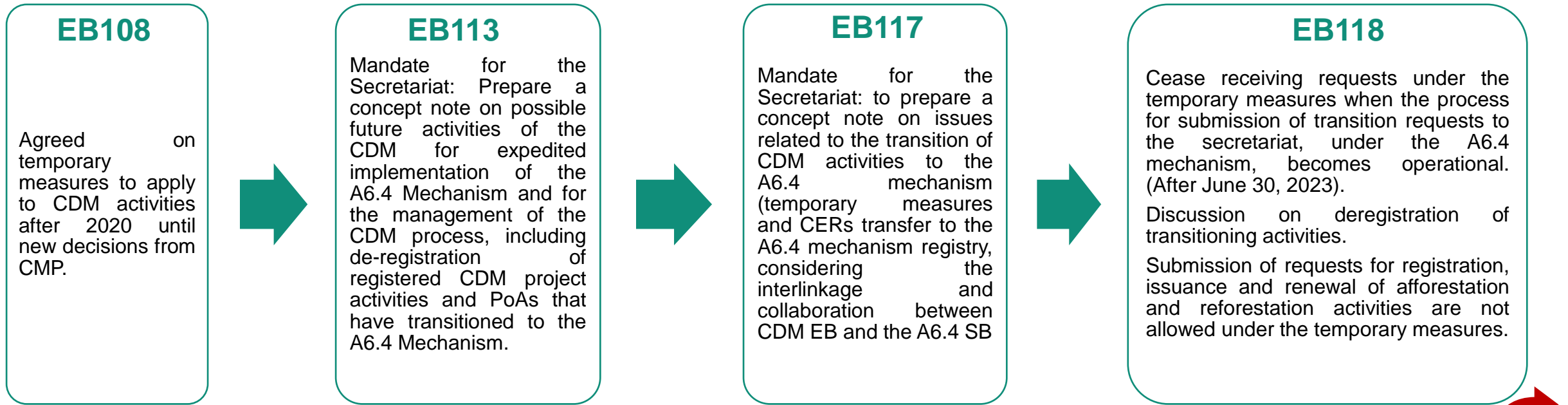

Ongoing Work under the CDM Executive Board (EB)

CDM EB

Supervises the Kyoto Protocol's CDM under the **authority and guidance of the CMP**. The EB is fully accountable to the CMP and is the ultimate point of contact for CDM project participants for the registration of projects and the issuance of CERs.

Ongoing Work under the CDM Executive Board (EB)

The CDM EB continued operating the temporary measures agreed at EB 108 for post2020 cases (requests for registration, renewal of crediting period or PoAs period, inclusion of CPAs in a registered PoAs and issuance relating to emission reductions for the period after 31 December 2020 until **the process under A6.4 Mechanism is operational***.

*The SB adopted during its 6th meeting the standard and procedure for the transition of CDM activities to the Article 6.4 mechanism (to be effective from January 1st, 2024). However, SB started processing requests for transition of CDM activities to the Article 6.4 mechanism as of 30 June 2023.

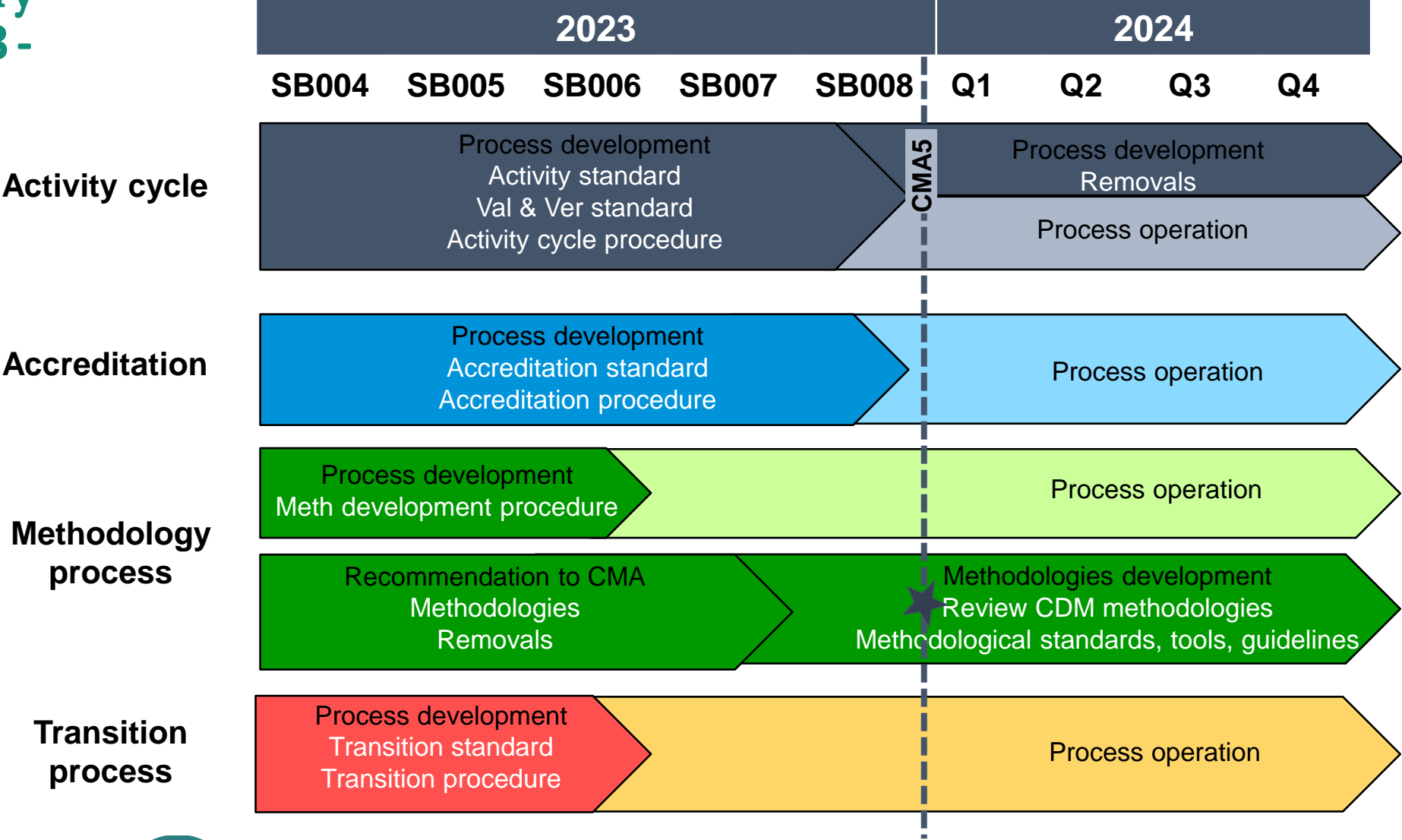

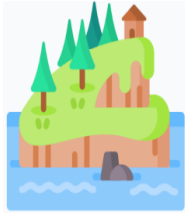

Least Developed Countries & Small Island Developing States

The SB requested the secretariat to include components that recognize the special circumstances LDCs and SIDS where the Article 6.4 mechanism RMPs relate to NDCs.



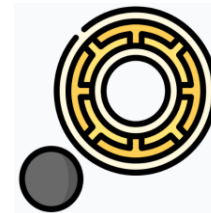
Gender

- **Decision 3/CMA.3 para. 5(i)** – Requests the SB to consider the gender action plan and the incorporation of relevant actions into the work of the Supervisory Body
- SB Work plan – Concept note on gender action plan to be considered in SB 006 (July 2023)



Small and Micro businesses

The SB agreed to consider the inclusion of provisions that specifically address small-scale and micro-scale activities as a means of supporting these businesses in the development methodologies, on a case-by-case basis.



Local Communities & Indigenous Peoples

- **Decision 3/CMA.3 para. 5(h)** – Requests the SB to consider opportunities to engage with the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform and its Facilitative Working Group
- SB Work plan – Concept note on engagements with LCIPP to be considered in SB 006 (July 2023)



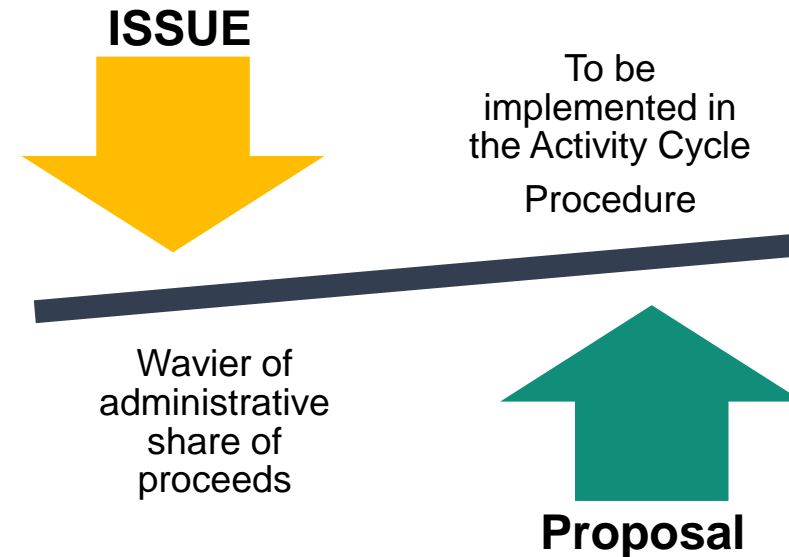
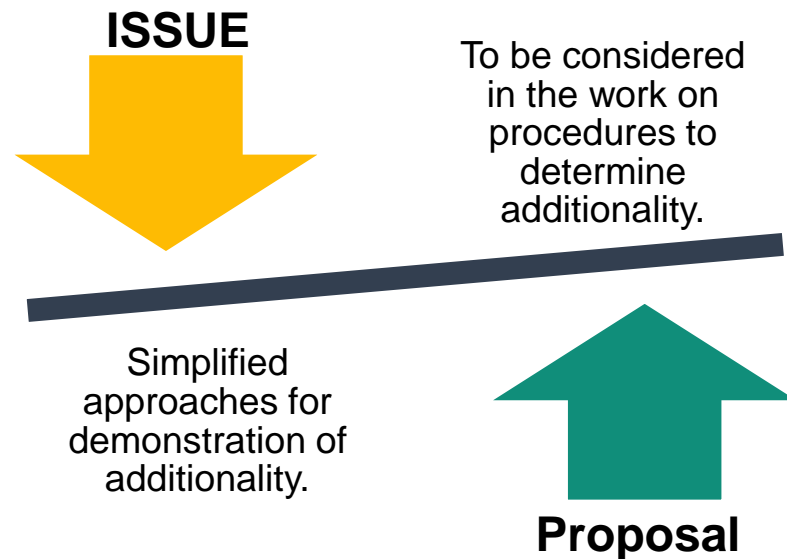
