Draft conclusions proposed by the co-facilitators

- 1. [The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) reaffirmed the importance of greenhouse gas emission data being easily accessible on the UNFCCC website.
- 2. The SBSTA requested the secretariat to prepare a technical paper on the work necessary to update the greenhouse gas data interface to enable the inclusion of data reported under the enhanced transparency framework under the Paris Agreement, including:
- (a) Details of the action necessary to extend the greenhouse gas data interface to enable it to copy information mirroring data reported by Parties included in Annex I to the Convention that are also Parties to the Paris Agreement, while continuing to collate and display information submitted by Parties in fulfilment of their reporting obligations under the Convention for those that are not Parties to the Paris Agreement in accordance with paragraph 44 of decision 1/CP.24;
- (b) An estimate of the funding required to take the action referred to in paragraph 2(a) above.
- 3. The SBSTA agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBSTA 61 (November 2024), subject to the availability of the tools for reporting under the enhanced transparency framework and taking into account the technical paper referred to in paragraph 2 above, with a view to adopting conclusions on this matter at that session.]
