CMA 6 agenda item 4(b) Matters relating to the global stocktake: Report on the annual global stocktake dialogue referred to in paragraph 187 of decision 1/CMA.5

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The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement,

[Recalling decision 1/CMA.5,]

1. *Recalls* paragraph 187 of decision 1/CMA.5, in which the Chairs of the subsidiary bodies were requested to organize an annual GST dialogue starting at their sixtieth sessions to facilitate the sharing of knowledge and good practices on how the outcomes of the first global stocktake are informing Parties' preparation of their next NDCs in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Paris Agreement;
2. *Welcomes* efforts undertaken by Parties in preparing their next NDCs and *commends* Parties that have already communicated their next NDCs;
3. *Recalls* Article 4, paragraph 9, of the Paris Agreement, which states that each Party shall communicate a nationally determined contribution every five years in accordance with decision 1/CP.21 and any relevant decisions of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement and be informed by the outcomes of the global stocktake referred to in Article 14;
4. *Expresses appreciation* to the Chairs of the subsidiary bodies and the secretariat for organizing the [first] annual global stocktake dialogue,¹ held from 6 to 7 June 2024, and *thinks* the participating experts, presenters and representatives of Parties and relevant organizations for their presentations, contributions and rich sharing of views during the dialogue;
5. *Welcomes* the summary report on the [first] global stocktake dialogue,² which contains a factual summary of the deliberations at the dialogue;
6. *Notes with appreciation* the information, views and perspectives shared by Parties and non-Party stakeholders during the dialogue, including on how the outcome of the first global stocktake is informing the preparation of Parties' next round of NDCs, [domestic efforts being undertaken by Parties in preparing and implementing their NDCs and various cooperative efforts in preparing NDCs];

Compilation of substantive elements

The following elements provide a compilation of additional views expressed within the initial round of sharing of views discussing more substantive matters related to reflections on the GST dialogue, indicating that there was divergence between Parties in terms of having substantive elements reflected in this consideration of the report on the annual GST dialogue:

- Dialogue has successfully fulfilled mandate
- Nationally determined nature of all implementation of NDCs
- General commitment by Parties to implement the GST outcomes, especially collective goals
- Dialogue as a good exercise for exchange of experience and fruitful discussion, noting diversity of strategies and pathways to reflect GST outcomes in NDCs
- Reflect mandate with focus on the report and not content
- Enhancing international cooperation
- No guidance on NDCs
- Non-mitigation actions (response measures)
- Ambitious, absolute emission targets and 1.5 °C aligned NDCs (2035 NDCs key to keeping 1.5 °C within reach), *Para 39*
- Whole-of-government, -economy and -society approach, backed by policies and links with other strategies (NBSAPs), as well as gender-responsiveness
- Global efforts on emission reduction and energy transition, *Para 28*
- Aligning NDCs with LT-LEDS, *Para 40*
- Domestic measures aligned with policies and plans, *Article 4.2 of Paris Agreement*
- Advancing adaptation
- Unilateral measures, *Para 154*
- Just transition
