- Project period: April 2015 to December 2017 in two phases.
- Participating countries

Caribbean: Antigua and Barbuda, Dominica

Pacific Islands: Fiji, Papua New Guinea

Asia: Afghanistan, Cambodia, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka

Central Asia: Moldova, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan

Africa: Swaziland, Rwanda, Sao Tome, Guinea Bissau, Zimbabwe, Lesotho, Namibia, Mozambique, Zambia, Niger, Mauritania, Benin, Burundi, Chad, Congo, Eritrea, DR Congo, Senegal





Phase 1: Apr. 2015-Dec. 2015

UNEP-GEF INDC Support project & GSP for INDC preparation

- Objective: to assist participating countries in preparation of INDCs to submit before 1 Oct. 2015.
- Output: supported 36 countries (of which UDP assisted 31), of which 35 countries submitted their INDCs prior to Paris COP.
- Under GSP, 4 additional countries in 2017: Ethiopia, Sierra Leone, Dominican Republic, South Sudan

Activities

- Activity 1: Conducting capacity building workshops for national INDC coordinator and national expert for mitigation and adaptation (May and Jun 2015)
- Activity 2: Developing technical guidance material to enhance primary and secondary stakeholder knowledge on INDC process and contents
- Activity 3: Providing country specific technical support to the national INDC team and experts working on preparing INDC report.





Phase 2: Jan. 2016 - Dec. 2017

- UNEP-GEF INDC Support project & GSP for INDC preparation
- Facilitating Implementation Readiness for Mitigation (Danish Government)

Objective: facilitating preparation and implementation of NDCs and enhancement of understanding on NDC institutionalization

Activities and Outputs

- (i) Direct support to countries in enhancing understanding of NDC implementation and institutionalization
- (ii) Development of guidebooks
- a. Steps and processes required to prepare NDC and its implementation plans;
- b. Institutionalizing NDC preparation and implementation;
- c. MRV of NDC implementation to track progress of NDC implementation and reporting to UNFCCC
- (iii) Global/regional workshops to promote south-south dialogues on implementation of NDCs and sharing of experiences.
- (iv) Advisory notes for countries to enhance understanding of decisions related to NDCs in the Paris Agreement.






Taking stock of the (I)NDCs of developing countries: regional (I)NDC coverage of mitigation sectors and measures



NDC project under preparation

Objective: Facilitating implementation of climate-resilient and low-carbon development aligned with national and global goals

Project period: early 2019 – early 2023

Expected Outcome: Partner countries are applying a systematic approach to using policies and economic instruments that drives accelerated public and private investment in NDC implementation.


Target Outputs:

- 1: Partner institutions are leading NDC implementation and driving increasingly ambitious NDCs with the engagement and support of relevant national stakeholders
- 2: Relevant actors agree on policies and programmes needed to drive NDC implementation in the priority mitigation and/or adaptation sectors
- 3: Financial institutions at the national, regional, and global levels are motivated to develop investment plans or to make climate investments at the sector or project levels
- 4: Experiences and lessons are shared among partner countries and beyond, creating a foundation for enhanced ambition
