Co-chairs of the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance

I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations organizations and admitted intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations that His Excellency Sameh Shoukry, President of COP 27, CMP 17 and CMA 4, has appointed Fiona Gilbert (Australia) and Zaheer Fakir (South Africa) as co-chairs for 2023 of the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance. His Excellency Sameh Shoukry intends to issue a public letter to the co-chairs setting out his expectations for their work in line with the mandate from Sharm el-Sheikh. The letter will be made available in due course at https://unfccc.int/NCQG and at COP27 - Home.

The ad hoc work programme was established for 2022–2024, to be facilitated by two co-chairs, pursuant to decision 9/CMA.3. The appointed co-chairs are well versed in the UNFCCC process, having been actively engaged in addressing matters under and outside the Convention and the Paris Agreement.
