INFORMATION NOTE TO PARTIES

Nomination of candidates for appointment or election during the United Nations Climate Change Conference to be held in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt

This is to inform Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that nominations of candidates are invited for positions on the following bodies that are open for appointment or election during the United Nations Climate Change Conference to be held in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt, from 7 to 18 November 2022:

- Bureau of the Conference of the Parties, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement;
- Bureau of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation;
- Bureau of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice;
- Adaptation Committee;
- Adaptation Fund Board;
- Advisory Board of the Climate Technology Centre and Network;
- Consultative Group of Experts;
- Executive Board of the clean development mechanism;
- Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts;
- Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee;
- Paris Agreement Implementation and Compliance Committee;
- Paris Committee on Capacity-building;
- Technology Executive Committee.

With reference to the notifications dated <u>17 January 2022</u> and <u>21 February 2022</u>, Parties are urged to transmit the nominations and information on terms of office that are outstanding from the elections held at COP 26. Parties are invited to recall decisions 23/CP.18, 3/CP.23 and 3/CP.25 and to make additional efforts to improve the participation of women and achieve the goal of gender balance in bodies established under the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement. A gender composition of 39 per cent female and 61 per cent male has been reached for membership in relation to these bodies as at17 February in 2022.
