NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

The 5th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions 7/CP.24, 3/CMP.14 and 7/CMA.1, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, that the 5th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) will take place virtually from 11 to 12 October 2021 from 13:00 – 16:00 CEST each day, and on 13 October 2021 from 13:00 – 14:30 CEST; and in person, in Glasgow, United Kingdom from 28 October (14:30) to 30 October (12:30).
