
Draft conclusions proposed by the Chairs

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) recalled decisions 1/CP.16, 2/CP.17, 1/CP.18, 10/CP.21 and 18/CP.23, and continued their consideration of the scope of the next periodic review at this session.
- 2. The SBSTA and the SBI noted that Parties exchanged their views on this matter at this session.¹
- 3. The SBSTA and the SBI took note of decision 19/CMA.1 on the global stocktake, the Talanoa Dialogue undertaken in 2018² and the ongoing technical examination processes.³
- 4. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SB 51 (December 2019) with a view to forwarding a recommendation for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-fifth session (December 2019).
