**Scope of the next periodic review of the long-term global goal  
under the Convention and of overall progress towards

**Draft conclusions proposed by the Chairs**

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) recalled decisions 1/CP.16, 2/CP.17, 1/CP.18, 10/CP.21 and 18/CP.23, and continued their consideration of the scope of the next periodic review at this session.
2. The SBSTA and the SBI noted that Parties exchanged their views on this matter at this session.<sup>1</sup>
3. The SBSTA and the SBI took note of decision 19/CMA.1 on the global stocktake, the Talanoa Dialogue undertaken in 2018<sup>2</sup> and the ongoing technical examination processes.<sup>3</sup>
4. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SB 51 (December 2019) with a view to forwarding a recommendation for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-fifth session (December 2019).
