## Revision of the modalities and procedures for international assessment and review


## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) continued its consideration, as agreed at SBI 46,¹ of the revision of the modalities and procedures for international assessment and review (IAR).²
- 2. The SBI noted that the IAR process has contributed to enhancing the transparency of developed country Parties' progress towards their economy-wide emission reduction targets for 2020. It welcomed the engagement of 43 Parties in the first two cycles of the IAR and 41 Parties in the third cycle.
- 3. The SBI acknowledged the positive experience with the IAR process and its contribution to the adoption of the modalities, procedures and guidelines for the transparency framework for action and support referred to in Article 13 of the Paris Agreement.<sup>3</sup> In this context, the SBI agreed that gaining further experience in the IAR process would be useful.
- 4. The SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBI 54 (May–June 2021).
