Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) acknowledged the fruitful exchange that took place during the in-session multi-stakeholder workshop on implementing the functions of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform.¹
2. The SBSTA noted with appreciation the support provided by the Nordic Council of Ministers for work under the platform and the support provided by Canada for the workshop referred to in paragraph 1 above.
3. The SBSTA agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBSTA 49 (December 2018) on the basis of the draft decision text proposed by the co-facilitators of the informal consultations on this agenda item.²
