MESSAGE TO PARTIES

Launch of the public registries referred to in Article 4, paragraph 12, and Article 7, paragraph 12, of the Paris Agreement

I wish to draw the attention of Parties to the Convention and the Paris Agreement to the successful launch, on 1 June 2022, of the <u>public registry</u> referred to in Article 4, paragraph 12, of the Paris Agreement and the <u>public registry</u> referred to in Article 7, paragraph 12, of the Paris Agreement. The launch of the public registries, in accordance with decisions 20/CMA.3 and 21/CMA.3, signifies a key step towards implementing the Paris Agreement.

The modalities and procedures for the operation and use of the public registries referred to in decisions 5/CMA.1 and 10/CMA.1 serve as the basis for the development, implementation, operation and use of the public registries.

The secretariat is in the process of providing access rights to the public registries to all national focal points (NFPs) of Parties to the Paris Agreement. After obtaining access rights, NFPs will be able to communicate nationally determined contributions (NDCs) and adaptation communications using the submission interface of the respective public registry.

Each Party to the Paris Agreement is to communicate its NDCs through its NFP and record them in the public registry for NDCs. For questions on the public registry for NDCs and to request access rights for delegated users, NFPs can contact the secretariat at <u>ndc@unfccc.int</u> or <u>tools.support@unfccc.int</u>.

Each Party to the Paris Agreement can submit its adaptation communications through its NFP and record them in the public registry. For questions on the public registry for adaptation communications and to request access rights for delegated users, NFPs can contact the secretariat at <u>adaptation-</u> <u>communications@unfccc.int</u>.
