The workshop will be held in conjunction with the sixty-second session of the Subsidiary Bodies (SB62) at the World Conference Center Bonn, in Bonn, Germany, on **Tuesday**, **17, and Wednesday**, **18 June 2025,** from **3:00 p.m to 6:00 p.m. in Room Genf** and **10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m in Chamber Hall** respectively. As announced in the message dated 30 April 2025, the first workshop will focus on the overarching theme of different approaches to Article 2, paragraph 1(c) and its complementarity with Article 9 in diverse contexts.
