Further to our communication of $\underline{12 \text{ April } 2023}$ regarding the sixth technical expert dialogue under the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance, we are pleased to provide further information thereon.

The dialogue will take place in Bonn on **12 June 2023 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on 13 June 2023 from 2 to 6 p.m. Central European Summer Time** in conjunction with the fifty-eighth sessions of the subsidiary bodies under the theme of "**Quantity, mobilization and provision of financial sources**". Further details, including provisional programme and logistical information, will be made available in due course at <u>https://unfccc.int/NCQG</u>.

Recognizing that not all Parties may be able to attend the dialogue in person, arrangements are being made to facilitate active virtual participation. Parties are requested to consider participating virtually and, in case they decide to do so, to complete the registration form at https://forms.gle/choqgyNrV2mJBrir8 by Friday, 2 June 2023. Regarding on-site participation, the chairs and coordinators of the various negotiating groups will be contacted separately. Details regarding in-person and virtual participation in the dialogue will be communicated directly to registered participants.

In addition, to allow for inputs to be reflected in the organization of the sixth technical expert dialogue, we would like to remind Parties, constituted bodies under the Convention and the Paris Agreement, operating entities of the Financial Mechanism, climate finance institutions, observers and other stakeholders, particularly from the private sector, to submit views thereon on the basis of the guiding questions in the notification dated 12 April 2023 via the submission portal¹ by **Wednesday**, **10 May 2023**.

Finally, we would like to reiterate our intention to conduct the ad hoc work programme in an open, inclusive and transparent manner, ensuring participatory representativeness. As such, we will be available for informal meetings upon the request of any Party or regional group of Parties throughout May and can be reached via <u>NCQG@unfccc.int</u>.
