Dear colleagues,

Further to our communication of [12 April 2023](#) regarding the sixth technical expert dialogue under the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance, we are pleased to provide further information thereon.

The dialogue will take place in Bonn on **12 June 2023 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on 13 June 2023 from 2 to 6 p.m. Central European Summer Time** in conjunction with the fifty-eighth sessions of the subsidiary bodies under the theme of “**Quantity, mobilization and provision of financial sources**”. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, in-person observer participation might be limited. Participants are strongly encouraged to connect virtually. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the dialogue as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadline may not be processed. Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in the dialogue will be communicated directly to the registered participants.

In addition, to allow for inputs to be reflected in the organization of the sixth technical expert dialogue, we would like to remind Parties, constituted bodies under the Convention and the Paris Agreement, operating entities of the Financial Mechanism, climate finance institutions, observers and other stakeholders, particularly from the private sector, to submit views thereon on the basis of the guiding questions in the notification dated 12 April 2023 via the submission portal¹ by **Wednesday, 10 May 2023**.

Finally, we would like to reiterate our intention to conduct the ad hoc work programme in an open, inclusive and transparent manner, ensuring participatory representativeness. As such, we intend to organize an informal consultation with interested non-Party stakeholders during the second week of the fifty-eighth sessions of the subsidiary bodies. Further information on the time, date and venue of the consultation will be provided in due course.
