MESSAGE TO PARTIES, OBSERVER STATES AND OBSERVER ORGANIZATIONS

Call for experts for the Article 6.4 mechanism roster of experts

I am pleased to provide information to Parties and admitted observer organizations to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement on the launch of the call for experts for placement on the roster of experts for the mechanism established by Article 6, paragraph 4, of the Paris Agreement (Article 6.4 mechanism). At its third meeting, in November 2022, the Article 6.4 mechanism Supervisory Body decided to establish a roster of experts to support its forthcoming work. The roster has three specializations:

1. Accreditation
2. Methodologies
3. Climate policy

The Supervisory Body invites applications from experts wishing to be placed on the Article 6.4 mechanism roster of experts. The call is based on an application process and is open until 9 January 2023.

Experts on the roster will serve in an individual expert capacity and may be selected for specific tasks in support of the Supervisory Body's workplan.¹ Initial placement on the roster will be for a period of two years, with a possibility of renewal.

Female candidates from developing countries are particularly encouraged to apply. The Supervisory Body has stressed that diversity of candidates is to be considered during the selection process.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany and to constituency focal points of non-governmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties.
