Dear colleagues,

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its third session established the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance for 2022–2024 and requested the co-chairs of the ad hoc work programme to conduct four technical expert dialogues (TEDs) per year thereunder.¹

The fifth TED was held at the Vienna International Centre in Vienna from 8 to 10 March 2023.² The sixth TED was convened in conjunction with the fifty-eighth sessions of the subsidiary bodies, at the Ameron Bonn Hotel Königshof in Bonn from 12 to 13 June 2023 on the themes of **quantity, mobilization and provision of financial sources**.³

Further to the notification issued on 22 June 2023,⁴ we would like to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the seventh TED will take place in Geneva from **30 September 2023 to 2 October 2023** on the theme of **quality and transparency arrangements**. Further details, including the provisional programme and logistical information, will be made available in due course at <https://unfccc.int/NCQG>.

Recognizing that not all Parties may be able to attend the dialogue in person, arrangements are being made to facilitate active virtual participation. Parties are requested to consider participating virtually and, should they decide to do so, to complete the registration form at <https://forms.gle/ZcVxaXTwmm4gJw6S8> by **Friday, 15 September 2023**. Regarding on-site participation, the chairs and coordinators of the various negotiating groups will be contacted separately. Details regarding in-person and virtual participation in the dialogue will be communicated directly to registered participants.

In addition, to allow for inputs to be reflected in the organization of the seventh TED, we would like to remind Parties, constituted bodies under the Convention and the Paris Agreement, the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism, climate finance institutions, observers and other stakeholders, particularly from the private sector, to submit their views on the matter, on the basis of the guiding questions contained in the notification issued on 22 June 2023,⁵ via the submission portal⁶ by **Monday, 14 August 2023**.
