MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND ADMITTED OBSERVERS

Membership of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

Further to my [communication of 15 August 2024](#) regarding membership of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP), I am pleased to inform Parties and observers to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations and related organizations and specialized agencies, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers and other non-Party stakeholders, that 12 of the 14 members of the Facilitative Working Group (FWG) of the LCIPP have been appointed by their respective regional groups and constituencies and Indigenous Peoples organizations. The current list of appointees is available [here](#).

Parties are invited to recall decision 14/CP.29, paragraph 13, which stipulates that, “of the representatives who will be appointed as members of the FWG with a term beginning in June 2025, three Party representatives and three representatives from Indigenous Peoples organizations shall serve for a term of two years instead of three years, after which time all representatives shall serve for a term of three years in accordance with decision 2/CP.24.”

In addition, paragraph 14 of decision 14/CP.29 invites the FWG to decide which Party representatives and which representatives from Indigenous Peoples organizations shall serve for a term of two years, in a manner that ensures geographical and gender balance. The FWG will discuss the transition of its membership at its [13th meeting](#), which will be held from **10 to 13 June 2025 in Bonn, Germany**.
