MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVERS

High-level dialogue on Transparency “Boosting the implementation of the Enhanced Transparency Framework - Sharing experiences and sustaining momentum for BTR submissions”

9 June 2026

On behalf of the COP 30 Presidency, the incoming COP 31 Presidency, as well as the COP 29 Presidency and its initiative the [Baku Transparency Platform](#), I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations system and specialized agencies, and other relevant organizations, and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers, that a **high-level dialogue on Transparency, entitled “Boosting the implementation of the Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF): Sharing experiences and sustaining momentum for BTR submissions”**.

The dialogue will take place during the sixty-fourth sessions of the Subsidiary Bodies on **Tuesday, 9 June 2026 from 13:00 – 15:00 CEST**.

This Presidencies-led event, jointly organized by the [#Together4Transparency initiative](#) (#T4T) and the [Baku Transparency Platform](#), will bring together Heads of Delegation and senior Party representatives to reflect on progress made in implementing the ETF and to maintain political engagement for transparency under the Paris Agreement.

The dialogue will provide a space for sharing success stories, lessons learned, challenges faced regarding access to finance, and practical experiences from Parties that have successfully advanced their transparency systems and submitted their first Biennial Transparency Reports (BTR). It will also provide an opportunity to openly discuss remaining challenges and identify ways to strengthen support for countries’ reporting.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany, as well as United Nations system and specialized agencies and other relevant organizations and admitted observer organizations.

The event will highlight the importance of sustaining collective efforts to ensure timely preparation of BTR2, strengthen national transparency systems, and promote inclusive progress so that all Parties can effectively participate in the ETF.

The event is open for observers. After interventions by Parties and time permitting, observers will be given the opportunity to make interventions.
