MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVERS

High-level Events United Nations Climate Change Conference COP 30/CMP 20/CMA 7 Belém, Brazil

On behalf of the incoming COP 30, CMP 20 and CMA 7 Presidency, I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations system and specialized agencies and other relevant organizations, intergovernmental organizations and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers, and other non-Party stakeholders that the high-level events to be held during COP 30 are scheduled as follows:

- **Saturday, 15 November 2025** from 10:00 to 14:00 (GMT -3) - Third biennial high-level ministerial dialogue on climate finance regarding information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement.
- **Tuesday-Wednesday, 18-19 November 2025** from 10:00 to 13:00 (GMT -3) – Baku high-level dialogue on adaptation.
- **Tuesday, 18 November 2025** from 13:00 to 17:00 (GMT -3) – Third annual high-level ministerial round table on just transition as part of the United Arab Emirates just transition work programme.
- **Wednesday, 19 November 2025** from 10:00 to 13:00 (GMT -3) – 2025 annual high-level ministerial round table on pre-2030 ambition.
- **Thursday, 20 November 2025** from 16:00 to 17:30 (GMT -3) - High-level event on global climate action

Third biennial high-level ministerial dialogue on climate finance regarding information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement

The CMA at its first session, decided to convene biennial high-level ministerial dialogues (HLMD) on climate finance beginning in 2021, in the context of identification of indicative quantitative and qualitative information related to Article 9, paragraphs 1 and 3 of the Paris Agreement, as applicable, including as available, projected levels of public financial resources to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement.

The third HLMD will focus on showcasing short- and medium-term solutions for enhancing the predictability and delivery of financial support to developing countries and that contribute to advancing the implementation of Article 9.1 and 9.3 of the Paris Agreement and the qualitative and quantitative elements of the new collective quantified goal on climate finance (NCQG) set at COP 29.¹ Furthermore, the HLMD aims to provide space for Parties and stakeholders to showcase solutions for scaling up adaptation finance to support the urgent and evolving need to accelerate adaptation and build resilience in developing countries. The incoming COP 30 Presidency encourages participants, who are willing to do so, to announce actionable solutions and initiatives, including financial pledges, that contribute to the provision and mobilization of climate finance at scale, including for scaling up adaptation finance.

The COP 30 President will summarize the deliberations of the dialogue for consideration by CMA 9.

Baku high-level dialogue on adaptation

The CMA at its sixth session, decided to establish the Baku high-level dialogue on adaptation, to be convened on the margins of each session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement by the President of that session and the President of the previous session with the aim of identifying ways of enhancing the implementation of the United Arab Emirates Framework for Global Climate Resilience.

The COP 30 President will report on the outcomes of the dialogue at COP 30.
