## MESSAGE TO PARTIES TO THE PARIS AGREEMENT

## Call for input

Following the <u>tenth meeting of the Supervisory Body</u> of the Article 6.4 mechanism held from 26 February to March 1 2024 in Bonn Germany and in particular regarding mechanisms methodological products, the Supervisory Body decided to carry out further work in relation to documents developed during its ninth meeting, namely "<u>Requirements for the development and assessment of Article 6.4 mechanism methodologies</u>" (A6.4-SB009-A01) and "<u>Activities involving removals under the Article 6.4 mechanism</u>" (A6.4-SB009-A02) including the work to improve the understanding of concerns raised by Parties at CMA 5.

The Supervisory Body also agreed to open a call for inputs for a period of six (6) weeks from 4 March 2024, on these matters. Additionally, the Supervisory Board requested the secretariat to provide a compilation of inputs received, including a high-level analysis for consideration by the Supervisory Body prior to its twelfth meeting.

The <u>call for input</u> on these two matters is now and will remain open until **15 April 2024**. Parties to Paris Agreement are encouraged to provide comments on any section of the documents using the template provided on the <u>webpage</u>. Inputs should be submitted to the Supervisory Body via email to <u>A6.4mechanism-info@unfccc.int</u>.
