The secretariat refers to the [Message to Parties and observers](#) dated 29 January 2026 regarding the Climate Week-3,<sup>1</sup> which will be held from 21 to 25 April 2026 in Yeosu, Republic of Korea.

In this context, United Nations system and specialized agencies and other relevant organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations are invited to carefully review the information contained in sections I - IV of this communication.

## **I. Expression of interest and registration for mandated events**

Expression of interest procedures for each mandated event from DCPs, should be submitted through the centralised [Indico UN platform](#), which compiles the nomination forms for all events open for expression of interest; for ease of reference, the individual event expression of interest forms are also available below in their respective sections. **Indico UN platform is the only official channel for expressing interest for the events during the Climate Week-3.** The secretariat is not in a position to process expressions of interest submitted by any other method. Please note that it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each participant for swift processing of expressions of interest and initiating the registration process. Once a participant has been nominated for an event, they will receive an email with registration details via Indico UN platform. Logistical details related to travel and participation will be published on the [Climate Week-3 conference page](#).

UN organizations and admitted IGOs are encouraged to express interest on behalf of representatives with expertise and experience relevant to the event for which they are expressing interest.

Kindly note, in-person participants, who have expressed interest to participate in the events of Climate Week-3, will be self-funded and responsible for covering all expenses associated with the attendance of the Climate Week-3.

Details on using the Indico UN platform and steps to submit your expressions of interest are included in the guidelines for using the Indico UN platform, attached to this communication. Chapter 4 of the guidelines includes an access code, which should be used to access forms for expression of interest. The system will remain open for expression of interest until **27 March 2026, CET 23:59**.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the Climate Week-3 events as early as possible, the secretariat may not be in a position to process expression of interest of participants received after the deadline of **27 March 2026, CET 23:59**.

### **III. Implementation Forum**

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 23 and 24 April 2026 and will feature a series of events, including Implementation labs, Impact dialogues and COP presidency events, focused on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. The thematic focus of the events will be based on the six axes of the global climate action agenda<sup>10</sup> ensuring alignment to the first GST outcomes. The implementation forum is a key pillar of the Climate Weeks, under which Parties and non-Party stakeholders can exchange on practical implementation solutions. Convening these discussions at the Climate Weeks, it localizes the Action Agenda, highlighting region-specific initiatives while drawing on global expertise.
