MESSAGE TO UNITED NATIONS ORGANIZATIONS AND ADMITTED OBSERVER ORGANIZATIONS

Second dialogue under the United Arab Emirates work programme on just transition pathways

2 - 3 October 2024

I refer to the <u>Message to Parties and Observers</u> dated 29 July 2024 regarding the discussion topic for the Second dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme in October 2024 (JTWP) and am pleased to invite United Nations and related organizations and specialized agencies (UN organizations) and admitted intergovernmental organizations (IGOs) to the second dialogue under the UAE JTWP.

Under the guidance of the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA), Harry Vreuls, and Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), Nabeel Munir, the second dialogue will take place in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt from **2-3 October 2024** in a hybrid format.

Two full-day sessions are planned on October 2 and 3. The second dialogue is being organized pursuant to decision 3/CMA.5, by which the CMA decided that at least two dialogues shall be held each year as part of the work programme and requested the secretariat to organize those dialogues under the guidance of the Chair of SBSTA and Chair of SBI. The dialogue will be broadcast live for those interested in following the discussions.

Pursuant to the same decision, and in deciding on the topic for the second dialogue in a transparent and consultative manner, considering the outcomes of the first hybrid dialogue and the inputs provided by Parties during the joint contact group on the work programme in the light of the elements contained in paragraph 2 of decision 3/CMA.5 as invited by SB 60, the Chair of SBSTA and Chair of SBI have selected the topic: *"Ensuring support for people-centric and equitable just transition pathways with a focus on the whole-of-society approach and the workforce."*

The specific areas of focus will be

- 1. Approaches for empowering all actors and segments of the society for a fair and inclusive workforce transition to meet Paris Agreement goals;
- 2. Unpacking the full range of means of implementation (Finance, Technology and Capacity Building) for a just transition of the work force: exploring current approaches, opportunities and gaps; and
- 3. International cooperation and partnerships for people-centric and equitable just transitions.
