Dear colleagues,

As you may recall, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA) at its third session established the ad hoc work programme on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance (NCQG) for 2022–2024.¹ As co-chairs of the ad hoc work programme, we have been requested by the CMA to conduct at least three meetings under the ad hoc work programme this year, back-to-back with at least three technical expert dialogues (TEDs), with one dialogue to take place in advance of the sixtieth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (SB 60, June 2024), one in conjunction with those sessions and one well before CMA 6. Two of the dialogues should be organized in separate regions with a view to facilitating inclusive and balanced geographical participation.²

Following on the message issued on 2 July 2024³, we are pleased to notify United Nations organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations, that the **eleventh TED** and the **third meeting under the ad hoc work programme** will be held from **9 to 12 September 2024**, at **Heydar Aliyev Center** in **Baku, Azerbaijan.** Further details, including the provisional programme will be made available in due course at <u>https://unfccc.int/NCQG</u>.

Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, in-person observer participation might be limited. Participants are strongly encouraged to connect virtually. To register for virtual participation, kindly complete the registration form <u>here</u> by **Monday**, **26** August 2024.

Please be informed that onsite and virtual participation in the third meeting under the ad hoc work programme will be guided by the draft rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties and its subsidiary bodies,⁴ with a view to facilitating it in an open-ended, inclusive, and Party-driven manner open to observers.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the dialogue and the meeting under the ad hoc work programme as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadline may not be processed. Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in both events will be communicated directly to the registered participants.

Finally, we would like to emphasize our intention to chair the ad hoc work programme in an open, inclusive, and transparent manner and look forward to working with all Parties and non-Party
