Further to our message dated <u>24 April 2023</u> regarding the organization of the Sharm el-Sheikh dialogue, as referred to in paragraph 68 of decision 1/CMA.4, on the scope of Article 2, paragraph 1(c), of the Paris Agreement and its complementarity with Article 9 of the Paris Agreement, we are pleased to provide further information on the organization of the first workshop under the dialogue.

The workshop will be held at the United Nations Conference Center in Bangkok, Thailand on **Wednesday**, **19 and Thursday**, **20 July 2023** and is co-hosted by the Government of Thailand and the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia. Recognizing that not all Parties may be able to attend the workshop in person, arrangements are being made to facilitate active virtual participation. Parties are requested to consider participating virtually. Chairs and coordinators of negotiating groups will be contacted separately regarding in-person participation. Details regarding in-person and virtual participation in the workshop will be communicated directly to registered participants. In addition, the workshop will be broadcast live, and the link will be made available on the workshop web page referenced above.

To allow for inputs to be reflected in the organization of the workshop, we would like to remind Parties, relevant organizations and stakeholders to submit their views, as announced in the message dated 24 April 2023 with a revised timeline, to <u>ClimateFinance@unfccc.int</u> by **16 June 2023**.

Lastly, we would like to reiterate our intention to conduct the dialogue in an open, inclusive and transparent manner, ensuring participatory representativeness.
