Draft conclusions proposed by the co-facilitators

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) and the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) convened a joint contact group to consider matters relating to the work programme for urgently scaling up mitigation ambition and implementation referred to in paragraph 27 of decision 1/CMA.3.
2. The SBI and the SBSTA took note of the informal note¹ prepared by the co-facilitators of this matter, recognizing that the content therein does not represent consensus among Parties.
3. The SBI and the SBSTA agreed to continue work on matters relating to the work programme for urgently scaling up mitigation ambition and implementation referred to in paragraph 27 of decision 1/CMA.3, at their fifty-seventh sessions (November 2022), with a view to recommending a draft decision thereon for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its fourth session.
4. [The SBI and the SBSTA invited Parties to submit their views on this matter via the submission portal² by 30 September 2022.]
5. [The SBI and the SBSTA requested the secretariat to organize, under the guidance of their Chairs, a [virtual] workshop on the work programme referred to in paragraph 1 above, open to all Parties.]
6. The SBI and the SBSTA took note of the estimated budgetary implications of the activity to be undertaken by the secretariat referred to in paragraph 5 above.
7. They requested that the actions of the secretariat called for in these conclusions be undertaken subject to the availability of financial resources.
