NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

The 4th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions [7/CP.24](#), [3/CMP.14](#) and [7/CMA.1](#), I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, that the 4th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) will take place from 25 to 27 May 2021 (**PART. I**) and from 1 to 2 June 2021 (**PART.II**). Owing to current travel restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, it will be held in a virtual format from 13:00 to 16:00 Central European Time each day.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision [7/CMA.1](#), the meeting of the KCI will be open to attendance, as observers, by all Parties and accredited observer organizations unless otherwise decided by the KCI.

To register for the meeting, interested Party delegate should forward their request to KCI@unfccc.int. **Kindly note that only two representative per Party will be permitted to participate in the virtual meeting. All other interested observers may follow the meeting proceedings via live broadcast.** The deadline for registration as an observer is **Monday, 3 May 2021**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
