6-8 July 2022

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the 16th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts will take place in Bonn, with virtual participation possible, from 6 to 8 July 2022.
