I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **20**th **meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw**International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts will take place, in person, from 12 March to 15 March in Bonn, Germany.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.20, the meeting will be open to attendance by Parties and observer States, except where otherwise decided by the Executive Committee.
