Africa and Asia biregional gathering of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

13–16 October 2022 N'Djamena, Chad

I wish to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations Secretariat units and bodies, specialized agencies and related organizations and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers, that the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP) bi-regional gathering for the Asia and Africa region will take place in N'Djamena, Chad from 13 to 16 October 2022.

This biregional gathering aims to bring together indigenous peoples, local communities, Parties, and other relevant stakeholders to exchange experience and practices in reducing greenhouse gas emissions and building climate resilience.
