NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES, OBSERVER STATES AND OBSERVER ORGANIZATIONS

1st meeting of the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body 25–28 July 2022

Pursuant to decision 3/CMA.3, I am pleased to notify Parties, observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations organizations, and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers that the 1st meeting of the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body will take place in Bonn, Germany from 25 to 28 July 2022.

Owing to restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, seating capacity in meeting rooms might have to be reduced and observer participation might need to be limited.
