I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **sixth meeting of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform** will take place in Glasgow from 28 to 30 October 2021.
