The 6th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions 7/CP.24, 3/CMP.14 and 7/CMA.1, I am pleased to inform the constituencies of non-governmental organizations that the 6th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) is planned to take place in Bonn from 2 to 3 June 2022.

In accordance with the modalities adopted by decision <u>7/CMA.1</u>, the meeting of the KCI will be open to attendance as observers by Parties and accredited observer organizations, unless otherwise decided by the KCI.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. The deadline for registration as an observer is **Friday**, **29** April **2022**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
