**Twenty-second meeting of the Adaptation Committee**  
**6–9 September 2022**

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the twenty-second meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place from 6 to 9 September 2022 in Bonn, Germany.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to observers, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Participation will be limited to two representatives for each of the nine constituencies.

Owing to restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, seating capacity in meeting rooms might have to be reduced and therefore observer participation might need to be limited.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points.

The deadline for registration as an observer is **Monday, 8 August 2022**. Please be advised that the secretariat will not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
