8th Meeting of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

1–4 November 2022

I am pleased to notify admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the 8th meeting of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform will take place in Sharm el Sheikh from 1 to 4 November 2022.

The meeting will be open to contributors in accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.24. The Facilitative Working Group strives for inclusiveness in its work.

Contributors from accredited non-governmental organizations to the UNFCCC and who would like to attend must be nominated by their constituency focal point.

The deadline for the Constituency Focal Points to submit registrations is **Friday, 30 September 2022**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations for contributors from accredited non-governmental organizations received after this deadline may not be processed. Once nominated by the constituency focal point, contributors must register for the meeting using the observer registration form for NGOs, which can be obtained from the constituency focal points. The completed form should be returned to the focal point. Upon receiving the registration form, the constituency focal points should confirm the nomination(s) and forward the registration form to the secretariat at <u>cool@unfccc.int</u>.
