NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

The 14th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol, and the Paris Agreement that the 14th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) will take place in **Bonn, Germany, on Thursday, 4 June and Friday, 5 June 2026.**

In accordance with the modalities adopted by decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, the meeting of the KCI will be open to attendance, as observers, by Parties and accredited observer organizations unless otherwise decided by the KCI.

To register representatives for the meeting, the National Focal Points (NFPs) of interested Parties and observer States are requested to submit their nominations via [Indico](#). Nominations of representatives received from other persons or Groups will need to be endorsed by their respective NFP.

The deadline for registration as an observer(s) for the meeting is **Thursday, 30 April 2026**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
