## 15<sup>th</sup> Nairobi work programme Focal Point Forum 11 November 2022

I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change that the **15<sup>th</sup> Focal Point Forum of the Nairobi work programme (NWP)** will be held during the 27th session of the Conference of the Parties in Sharm el-Sheikh, Arab Republic of Egypt, on 11 November 2022, from 18:00 to 20:00.

The Focal Point Forum<sup>1</sup> will be held under the guidance of the Chair of the SBSTA. It will provide an interactive space that contributes to scaling up adaptation action through knowledge. The forum will foster dialogue and knowledge-sharing among Parties, UNFCCC national focal points, NWP thematic expert groups and partners, and UNFCCC constituted bodies. The forum will launch the adaptation thematic area of agriculture and food security.

The forum will explore the implementation of adaptation practices and results in agriculture and food security, and how these can feature in national adaptation plans and build resilience in support of the Paris Agreement. The focal point forum will be organized with engagement of NWP thematic expert groups, focal points, and constituted bodies. It will highlight adaptation practices at the subregional level scale up adaptation through knowledge.
