NOTIFICATION

Events relating to Article 6 of the Paris Agreement

25–28 October 2023

Pursuant to the conclusions of SBSTA 58,¹ I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the following events will be held in hybrid format between **25 and 28 October 2023** in Bonn:

- Voluntary forum of Article 6 registry system administrators and technical experts² on **25 October 2023**;
- Technical expert dialogue³ on the matters referred to in related to Article 6.4, including a joint session on their relation to corresponding matters under the cooperative approaches referred to in Article 6, paragraph 2, of the Paris Agreement; and
- Workshop to consider the technical paper on the elements referred to in paragraph 92(a–d) of document FCCC/SBSTA/2023/4 related to Article 6.2 from **26 to 28 October 2023**.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany.

Interested representatives of Parties or observer States and chairs or coordinators of negotiating group in the UNFCCC process should register their nominations to attend the above-mentioned events by sending the name(s) and contact details of the representative(s) by email to Paris-Agreement-Article-6@unfccc.int. The deadline for nominations is **Monday, 4 September 2023**. In view of the need to coordinate arrangements, registrations received after this deadline may not be processed.

Once the nomination has been confirmed by the national focal point or negotiating group chair or coordinator, nominated participants must register via the registration link that they will be provided following their nomination.

Owing to funding limitations, the secretariat will be able to support only a limited number of funded participants to attend the events in person in Bonn. Financial support covering all four days will be provided to **one participant from each eligible negotiating groups**.

The events will be open to United Nations organizations and admitted observer organizations. Given space limitations, attendance for observers is limited to **virtual participation only**.
