### **The twenty-first meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts**

**11–13 September 2024**

I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **21<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts** will take place, in person, from **11 September to 13 September 2024** in Bonn, Germany.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.20, the meeting will be open to attendance by Parties and observer States, except where otherwise decided by the Executive Committee.
