NOTIFICATION

High-level Ministerial Dialogues on the New Collective Quantified Goal on Climate Finance

Sharm El-Sheikh, Arab Republic of Egypt

I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) that the **first high-level ministerial dialogue on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance** will take place on **Wednesday, 09 November 2022 from 15:00 to 18:00** in conference premises in Sharm El-Sheikh, Arab Republic of Egypt (Egypt).

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA), at its third session, decided to convene high-level ministerial dialogues on climate finance starting in 2022 and ending in 2024, ensuring effective political engagement and open, meaningful, and robust discussion. The high-level ministerial dialogue will be informed by the reports on the technical expert dialogues, submissions by Parties and non-Party stakeholders on the new collective quantified goals, and the technical paper prepared by the UNFCCC secretariat on the submissions.

This dialogue aims to provide guidance on the further direction of the ad hoc work programme the following year. The CMA 4 President will prepare a summary of the deliberations at the high-level ministerial dialogue, including recommendations, for consideration by CMA 4.

The dialogue will have a webcast. While the ministerial dialogue is open to all Parties and observers, owing to the limited capacity of the meeting room, the access to Parties and Party observers will be limited to participating minister or head of delegation +1.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany.
