## NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

### **The 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures**

Pursuant to decisions [13/CP.28](#), [4/CMP.18](#) and [19/CMA.5](#), I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) is planned to take place in Bonn, Germany, from 30 to 31 May 2024.
