NOTIFICATION TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

The 12th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol, and the Paris Agreement that the 12th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) will take place in Bonn, Germany, from 12 to 13 June 2025.

In accordance with the modalities adopted by decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, the meeting of the KCI will be open to attendance as observers by Parties and accredited observer organizations unless otherwise decided by the KCI.

To register for participation in the meeting, the National Focal Points (NFPs) of interested Parties and observer States should email their request to KCI@unfccc.int. Nominations of representatives received from other persons or Groups will need to be endorsed by their respective NFP. Following the nomination or endorsement by the NFP, the registration link, with instructions for completing the registration form, will be provided to the nominated representatives.

The deadline for registration as an observer for the meeting is **Friday, 11 April 2025**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
