Virtual briefing on the implementation of the UNFCCC 2020–2021 budget and secretariat structure 26 and 27 November 2020

In June 2020, the secretariat organized a <u>virtual briefing</u> for Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement (from now on referred to simply as Parties and observer States) on the implementation of the UNFCCC 2020–2021 budget and secretariat structure as part of the ongoing efforts to enhance transparency and clarity on these matters. The briefing was chaired by the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI).

I am pleased to share the format of the virtual briefing that will be held as part of the <u>UN Climate</u> <u>Change Dialogues 2020</u>.

Similar to the June briefing, two live Q&A sessions will be held to accommodate different time zones and will aim to cover the same information. These will take place on:

Thursday, 26 November: 16:00-18:00 CET
 Friday, 27 November: 08:00-10:00 CET

On Friday, 20 November 2020, in advance of the live sessions, the secretariat will make available on the <u>UNFCCC Budget webpage</u>, overview presentations of the briefing as background information to participants on the following topics:

- Part A the UN Board of Auditors will focus on the 2019 External Audit Report.
- Part B the secretariat will focus on:
 - (1) The implementation of the UNFCCC budget 2020-2021, including the status of contributions and implementation rate;
 - (2) The status of implementation of the secretariat structure;
 - (3) Preliminary information on the 2022-23 budget.
