## NOTIFICATION

### Thematic focus of the 2025 Dialogue on Action for Climate Empowerment

I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations and related organizations, specialized agencies and intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations admitted as observers about this year's Dialogue on Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) to be held during SB 62 (June 2025) in Bonn. The secretariat proposes to focus the Dialogue on the priority areas under the Glasgow work programme on ACE<sup>1</sup> of *policy coherence and coordinated action*.

This proposal aims the focus of the ACE Dialogue to align to activities under the action plan of the Glasgow work programme,<sup>2</sup> which requests the secretariat to organize, at the 2025 ACE Dialogue, a joint session with representatives of the UNFCCC constituted bodies and all work programmes under the UNFCCC to discuss ways of enhancing understanding of the role of children and youth and Indigenous Peoples in accelerating ACE implementation and promoting intergenerational knowledge-sharing in the context of their work (activity A.1); and an interactive workshop on developing and implementing national climate change policies, plans, strategies and action using a clear, inclusive, intergenerational and gender-responsive approach (activity A.2).

By addressing the priority areas of *policy coherence* and *coordinated action* this year, we aim to ensure the ACE Dialogues cover all priority areas before the midterm review of the Glasgow work programme, which will be the focus of the ACE Dialogue in 2026.

The deadline for submissions<sup>3</sup> to inform this year's ACE Dialogue, including suggestions for proposed speakers and lists of guiding questions, is **Thursday, 28 February 2025**.
