2024 Dialogue on Action for Climate Empowerment – Extension of Deadline

I am pleased to convey to Parties and observers to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations and related organizations and specialized agencies, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers and other non-Party stakeholders that, in response to requests from Parties and non-Party stakeholders, the deadline for submissions to inform this year's Dialogue on Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) to be held during SB 60 (June 2024) in Bonn has been extended until **Friday**, **15 March 2024**.

As stated in my previous notification, the secretariat proposes to focus the Dialogue on the priority area under the Glasgow work programme on Action for Climate Empowerment¹ of *tools and support* to align it to activity C.3 under the <u>action plan</u> of the Glasgow work programme, which requests the secretariat to organize an expert-run session at the ACE Dialogue in 2024 on how to write strong project proposals to support the implementation of ACE activities.

I would like to take this opportunity to encourage Parties to nominate their <u>national ACE focal</u> <u>points</u> and provide the necessary support for them to actively take part in the 2024 ACE Dialogue. The procedure to nominate a national ACE Focal Point is available <u>here.</u>
