MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVERS

Call for input on the Second Review of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building

I wish to inform Parties and observers to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations and related organizations and specialized agencies, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers that on 10 January 2024, the secretariat launched a call for input on the second review of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building in accordance with Decisions 12/CP.28 paragraph 3, 16/CMA.5 paragraph 4.

Parties, constituted bodies under the Convention and the Paris Agreement, operating entities of the Financial Mechanism, representatives of relevant processes under the Convention, and non-Party stakeholders were invited in their respective capacity to provide input, based on the Terms of Reference contained in the annex of the decisions, for consideration by the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) at its sixtieth session to be held in June 2024.

Upon the request of Parties and in consultation with the chair of the SBI Mr. Nabeel Munir, the secretariat would like to inform Parties and observers that the deadline for submissions via the dedicated submission portal has been extended to 31 March 2024.
