## NOTIFICATION

### **The 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building 12–14 June 2023 Bonn, Germany**

I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement, United Nations organizations and admitted observer organizations that the **7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building (PCCB)** will take place in person from 12 to 14 June 2023, in Bonn, Germany.

The 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the PCCB will be open to observers. National focal points and focal points of observer organizations are invited to nominate their representatives for the meeting. In accordance with decision 23/CP.18 and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, the UNFCCC secretariat encourages the nomination of women participants.

Nominated representatives should register for the meeting using the dedicated online registration form available at <https://indico.un.org/event/1004881/>. The deadline for registration as an observer is **Friday, 2 June 2023**. Please note that the secretariat may not be in a position to process registrations received after this deadline. Please also note that, for logistical reasons, in-person participation may need to be limited. A webcast of the meeting will be available on the UNFCCC website for those representatives who are unable to participate in person.

As the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the PCCB will be taking place on the margins of the fifty-eighth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (5–15 June 2023), in-person observers are advised that they will need separate accreditation for both the meeting and the sessions.
