Tenth Durban Forum on Capacity-building 2 June 2021

The UNFCCC secretariat herewith would like to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) that the tenth Durban Forum on Capacity-building will take place on 2 June 2021.

Because of current travel restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 virus, this year's Durban Forum will be held in a virtual format. Registered participants will have access rights enabling them to participate actively in the meeting. A live webcast of the meeting will also be available for others to observe the meeting.

Please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process registrations received after this deadline. In accordance with the Conference of the Parties decision 23/CP.18, and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, the UNFCCC secretariat encourages nomination of women participants to attend the tenth Durban Forum.
